

From IKAJA in Tokyo

Kamishibai Newsletter Volume 12 focuses on kamishibai about peace.

One of the subgroups in which IKAJA leaders learn together is our peace kamishibai forum. Its members perform and discuss kamishibai that take peace as their theme.

The members have come to believe that peace kamishibai “probe the essence of war, see war for what it is, and voice the fervent desire to live.” We believe such kamishibai give children an anchor for living life.

In a recent issue of our Japanese newsletter we featured five peace kamishibai: *Never Again*, *Wild Roses*, *The Ocean of Kariyushi*, *The Oath of Peace*, and *The Ivory Comb*. In this issue we would like to explore peace kamishibai with a focus on two of these works: *Wild Roses* and *The Ocean of Kariyushi*. For each of these kamishibai we include full text, as well as commentary, in translation.





The International Kamishibai Association of Japan (IKAJA) is Japan's largest kamishibai association. The spokesperson is now Kyoko Sakai, chair of the publishing company Doshinsha. Noriko Matsui, creator of kamishibai and picture books, remains as advisor.

Since the establishment of IKAJA in 2001, we have held 29 domestic kamishibai seminars and issued 27 semiannual Japanese newsletters as well as 11 annual English newsletters. We have also sent delegations to many countries to organize seminars and workshops. We co-organized the first European Kamishibai Meeting at UNESCO in Paris in cooperation with la Petite Bibliothèque Ronde in 2012. For more details, please kindly see our website.


